

## Steel City 2-Gun Match

Steel City will hold a 2-gun match (carbine/pistol) on Saturday, March 31<sup>st</sup> 2012. Shooter's meeting will begin start at 8:00am and the match will start promptly at 9:00am. The match will consist of 6 stages and each stage will incorporate both the carbine and pistol.

### **Categories:**

We will recognize the winners of the following 5 shooting categories with plaque trophies. Equipment for each category will be consistent with our Steel City Multi-gun rules. **Open** – No equipment restrictions – See multigun rules for details

**Tactical Optics** – Multigun rules for carbine/pistol – 30 round magazine limit for carbine

**Tactical Irons** – Multigun rules for carbine/pistol – 30 round magazine limit for carbine

**Heavy Optics** – Multigun rules for rifle/pistol – 20rnd mag for rifle, 10rnd mag for pistol

**Heavy Irons** – Multigun rules for rifle/pistol – 20rnd mag for rifle, 10rnd mag for pistol.

**Note:** There may be stages where you will shoot your carbine dry and transition to your pistol. A sling will be necessary for some of these stages. You are not required to have your sling on your carbine for the entire match, but you will need a sling or carry strap to shoot some stages.

### **Scoring:**

The scoring will be simple and quick to calculate and record. Target neutralization is the same for all categories:

- 1) Paper targets – all paper targets will require 2 hits anywhere to neutralize. +5 seconds for only 1 hit, +10 seconds for no hits.
- 2) Steel targets – knocked over or activated (rifle flash targets) to neutralize.

### **Registration:**

This match will accommodate 60 pre-registered shooters. If the match fills, a waiting list will be maintained. The match fee is \$50. Please send your match fee when you submit your registration.
